# **Terms and Conditions**

### Membership

- 1. Membership fees are reviewed and set by the executive committee annually.
- 2. Fees are due for payment on 1<sup>st</sup> March each year.
- 3. Any new membership applications processed after 1<sup>st</sup> January each year will be considered to be valid until 28<sup>th</sup> February of the following year.
- 4. A member shall be considered a "member in good standing" only when their annual dues have been paid.
- 5. Member only access to the ADNA website will be disabled if you have allowed your membership to lapse.

### **State Education Days**

- 1. ADNA organises a state education day in the following states each year: NSW, Queensland, Victoria, South Australia, &Western Australia.
- 2. The state representatives will determine the date and venue.
- 3. The executive committee will set the cost.
- 4. If fewer than 20 nurses have registered 2 weeks prior to the event, then the event will be cancelled.
- 5. Members in good standing may attend at a reduced "members fee".
- 6. Student nurses (with proof of ID) may attend at the reduced member's fee.
- 7. All other registrants will pay the full fee.
- 8. Cancellations over 2 weeks before the event will incur a \$10 administration fee.
- 9. Cancellations under 2 weeks before the event will not be refunded. Substitute delegates will be accepted, provided they pay the correct fee. \*
- 10. Delegates are responsible for their own transport to and from the education day, and for their own parking costs.

#### **ADNA National Conference**

- 1. The ADNA national conference is held concurrently with the Australian College of Dermatologists (ACD) annual scientific meeting.
- 2. The ACD determines the venue city.
- 3. Where possible, the ADNA conference will be held in the same complex.
- 4. The executive committee will set the cost of the conference.
- 5. Members in good standing may attend at a reduced "members fee".
- 6. Student nurses (with proof of ID) may attend at the discounted member's fee.
- 7. All other registrants will pay the full fee.
- 8. Cancellations over 2 weeks will incur a \$50 administration fee.
- 9. Cancellations under 2 weeks will not be refunded. Substitute delegates will be accepted, provided they pay the correct fee. \*
- 10. Members who are registered for the entire conference may attend social events (as specified on the registration form) at no additional cost.
- 11. Priority for social functions goes to ADNA members.
- 12. Student nurses and non-members will be expected to pay a fee to attend these social functions.
- 13. As places at social events are limited, your partner may attend at a cost *only if there are positions available*. Nurses who are registered for the conference get first refusal.
- 14. Delegates are responsible for their own transport to and from the conference, and for their own accommodation and/or parking costs.

### **Continuing Professional Development**

- 1. Delegates attending ADNA run education days and the ADNA national conference will be awarded CPD points.
- 2. It is the delegate's responsibility to record them properly with stated aims and outcomes recorded.
- 3. The points are allocated by the ACN/ADNA liaison officer according to accepted criteria and regulations. APEC Number ID 418
- 4. Points for presentations will also be allocated by the ACN/ ADNA liaison officer. APEC Number ID 418
- 5. Only delegates who attend and <u>sign in each day</u> will receive the certificate of attendance.
- 6. There are only 10 points available to be allocated for a 30 minute presentation. E.g. If you share a presentation with another nurse, then you will only receive ½ the points.
